

SimNet is the computer based testing system that is used in the CSCI 101A,B,C labs and you must have a SimNet account to take the lab tests. The following explains how you will login into SimNet.

1. Start Internet Explorer and type in the web address [Winthrop.SimnetOnLine.com](http://Winthrop.SimnetOnLine.com) (or click on this link)



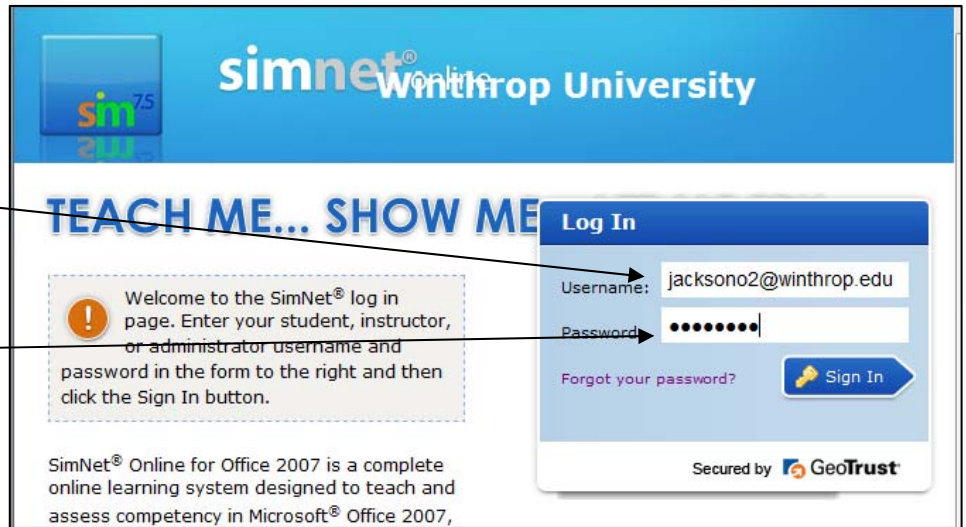
You should get a login window:

2. Your SimNet account should already be created AND you should already be a fully registered student of SimNet.

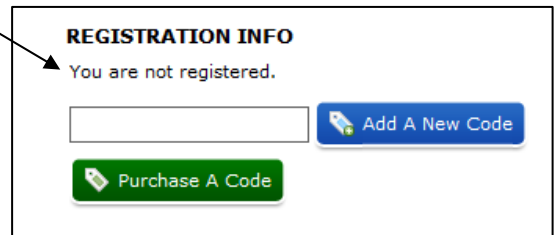
**You do NOT need to purchase a registration code.**

3. Login into SimNet:

- Your SimNet username is your Winthrop email address
- Your SimNet password is your Winthrop Student ID number as your password (the 8-digit Winthrop SID number, NOT your Social Security Number). If you do not know your Winthrop SID number, login to Wingspan (in another browser window), and get your 8-digit ID number.



- Enter your username and password in the login box and click "Sign In".
- If you properly entered your username and password, then you should get a window showing your name, your assigned lab sections, and your Registration information.
- If the registration information says "You are not registered", then immediately email [Kent Foster](mailto:Kent Foster), the Director of the CSCI 101 labs, at [foster@winthrop.edu](mailto:foster@winthrop.edu) and include your name, your Winthrop SID number and the CSCI 101 lab section that you are registered for in your email.



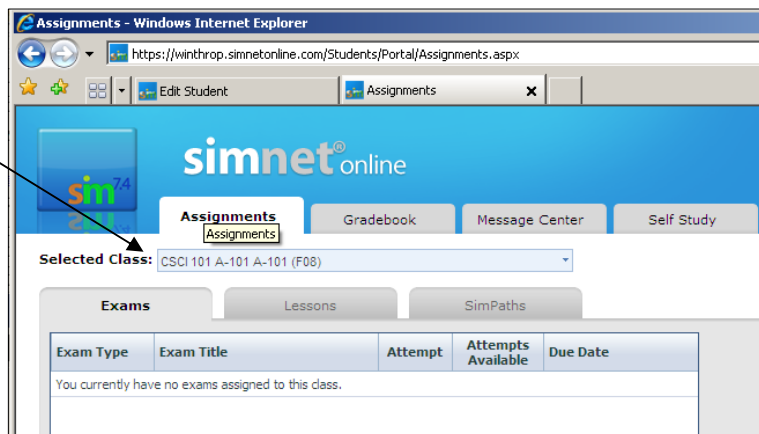
**DO NOT PURCHASE a registration code !!!**

The university purchases the registration codes for all students registered in the CSCI 101A, B and C labs, so you do not need to purchase the code.

If you entered the correct username and password, you will then get your SimNet student screen that looks something like this:
